Department News

Drs. Sylvia Fitting, Kurt Gray, and Kristen Lindquist are recipients of the UNC Junior Faculty Development Award, paid from the IBM and R.J. Reynolds Industries Funds and awarded to assistant and associate professors.

Dr. Fitting won for her project examining how synthetic cannabinoids and endocannabinoids differentially affect neuronal and synaptic activity within the context of HIV-1 infection. Dr. Gray won for his project investigating the dying positivity effect and how dying can be positive. Dr. Lindquist won for her project aiming to understand the cognitive and neural mechanisms that create healthy emotions.

Dr. Steven Reznick was inducted into the Order of the Long Leaf Pine on November 20, 2015. He was nominated by Dr. Daniel Gitterman, Chair of Public Policy. The Order of the Long Leaf Pine is among the most sought after and valued awards conferred by the Governor of North Carolina. Dr. Reznick won for his scientific contributions and his demonstration of a lifetime of service to the State.

Dr. Reznick's primary scientific contributions have been made in the domain of infant cognitive development, covering topics such as working memory, attention, and language development.

2016 Distinguished Alumnus

The Colloquium Committee in the Department of Psychology and Neuroscience is pleased to announce that the recipient of this year's Distinguished Alumnus Award is **Dr. Ronald Haskins**, who earned his Ph.D. in the Developmental Psychology Program. He was a senior researcher at the Frank Porter Graham Child Development Center at UNC Chapel Hill from 1981 to 1985.



A former senior White House and congressional advisor on welfare issues, Dr. Haskins co-directs the Brookings Center on Children and families and Budgeting for National Priorities Project. An expert on preschool, foster care, and poverty, he was instrumental in the 1996 overhaul of national welfare policy. He is also a contributor to the Evidence Speakers paper project.

Dr. Haskins was the editor of the 1996, 1998, and 2000 editions of the Green Book, a 1600 page compendium of the nation's social programs published by the House Ways and Means Committee that analyzes domestic policy issues including health care, poverty, and unemployment. He is the senior editor of *The Future of Children*, a journal on policy issues that affect children and families. He is a co-editor and contributor to numerous edited books and scholarly journals on chil-

dren's development and social policy issues.

His areas of expertise include welfare reform, child care, child support, marriage, child protection, and budget and deficit issues. In 1997, Dr. Haskins was selected by the *National Journal* as one of the 100 most influential people in the federal government. Dr. Haskins' talk, entitled "Social Science Rising: The Growing Influence of Evidence in Policy Development" is scheduled for Wednesday, February 24th from 3:30 to 4:30 pm in Davie Hall.

Our 2016 Department Colloquium features **Dr. Ernest C. Davenport**. Dr. Davenport is a professor in the Quantitative Methods in Education Program within the College of Educational Psychology and Human Development at the University of Minnesota.

He received a B.S. degree in Psychology and Computer Science from Duke University and his Masters and Doctoral degrees from the University of North Carolina Chapel Hill.

Dr. Davenport has had a longstanding role as the Director of an ACT/SAT review course for at-risk students and was one of the founders of Minnesota's Office of Educational Accountability (OEA), which was created to assist with educational accountability in the state.

His research primarily focuses on the study of measurement to better understand achievement gaps, with special interests in the relationship between student experiences and academic success.
