Each year, the University recognizes faculty, staff, and students for outstanding teaching. We are proud to announce that three Psychology and Neuroscience faculty members and one Cognitive Psychology graduate student are 2017 University Teaching Award winners!

Dr. Enrique Neblett, Associate Professor of Clinical Psychology, is a recipient of the 2017 Tanner Award for Excellence in Undergraduate Teaching. The Tanner Awards were created in 1952 to recognize excellence in inspirational teaching of undergraduate students.

Dr. Marsha Penner, Lecturer, is a recipient of the 2017 Johnston Teaching Excellence Award. This award was created in 1991 to recognize excellence in undergraduate teaching and are funded by the James M. Johnston Scholarship Program.

Dr. Charlie Wiss, Senior Lecturer, is a recipient of the 2017 William C. Friday Award for Excellence in Teaching. The Friday Award was created by members of the 1986 graduating class to recognize members of the faculty who have exemplified excellence in inspirational teaching and is named in honor of William C. Friday, who devoted a lifetime of service to the University as President of the UNC system.

S. Adam Smith, Cognitive Psychology graduate student, is a recipient of the 2017 Tanner Teaching Assistants Award for Excellence in Undergraduate Teaching.

Drs. Neblett, Penner, Wiss, and Mr. Smith will be recognized on Tuesday, January 31 during the half-time ceremony at the UNC-Pitt men's basketball game in the Dean E. Smith Center. Congratulations to our faculty and graduate student for winning these prestigious awards!



S. Adam Smith, a graduate student in Cognitive Psychology, is a Spring 2017 Future Faculty Fellow. The Future Faculty Fellowship Program (FFFP) is a UNC Center for Faculty Excellence graduate student initiative. FFFP is a semester-long program that introduces graduate students to evidence-based teaching practices, helps them understand the roles and responsibilities of faculty members at different types of institutions of higher education, and helps them reflect on their professional goals.
