Dr. Marsha Penner is the recipient of a 2017 Robert E. Bryan Public Service Award from the UNC Carolina Center for Public Service. The Bryan Award recognizes individuals at UNC for extraordinary public service and engagement. Dr. Penner won for her work in the community with the Neural Connections and was honored at an awards ceremony on April 5, 2017.



Cameron Doyle, a graduate student in Social Psychology, and Gabriella Alvarez, an incoming graduate student in Social Psychology, won National Science Foundation Graduate Research Fellowships. The NSF Graduate Research Fellowships recognize outstanding graduate students in the science, technology, engineering, and mathematics fields. NSF fellows receive three years of support and professional development opportunities.



Effua Sosoo, a graduate student in Clinical Psychology, is the recipient of a 2017 Ford Foundation Predoctoral Fellowship. The Ford Fellowship seeks to increase the diversity of the nation's faculties by increasing their ethnic/racial diversity, to maximize the educational benefits of diversity, and to increase the number of professors to use diversity as a resource to enrich the education of all students.



Shannon Blakey, a graduate student in Clinical Psychology, is the recipient of a 2017 Philanthropic Educational Organization (PEO) Scholar Award. These awards recognize excellence and provide partial support for study and research for women who will make significant contributions in their fields of endeavor.

Julia Browne, a graduate student in Clinical Psychology, is the recipient of a 2017 Graduate Education Advancement Board (GEAB) Impact Award. The longstanding GEAB Impact Award recognizes discoveries with a direct impact on our state in the present time. Julia won an Impact Award for her project, "Increasing Walking Among People with Schizophrenia. Statistics indicate that people with schizophrenia have a life expectancy up to 25 years shorter than people in the general population. This premature mortality often results from preventable causes, such as physical inactivity. Julia conducted a study with the goal of creating a cost-effective and accessible exercise intervention for North Carolinians with schizophrenia.

Julia and her research team created Work Out by Walking (WOW), which featured walking groups, pedometer use, social interaction, goal-setting, daily contact with research staff, feedback on progress and financial incentives. This 10-week program was offered to 16 individuals with schizophrenia who were receiving treatment at a community mental health center. Participants experienced notable improvement in their activity level, mental/physical health, quality of life, and perceived social support.

Julia and her mentor, Dr. David Penn, partnered with UNC Chapel Hill exercise physiology expert Dr. Claudio Battaglini and psychiatrist Dr. Fred Jarskog to develop an enhanced version of WOW. The updated intervention was tested in Fall 2016. Julia's continuing work provides a promising and innovative approach to exercise and may help North Carolinians with schizophrenia lead longer and more fulfilling lives.
