Chloe Bryen, a graduating senior, was this year's recipient of the Dashiell-Thurstone Prize. The Dashiell-Thurstone Prize is awarded each year for the best senior honors thesis, as judged by a faculty committee. This award is named in memory of two significant figures in the life of the Department: John Dashiell, who founded the Department in 1920, and Leon Thurstone, who founded the Psychometric Research Laboratory in 1953. Chloe won for her outstanding senior honors thesis, "Relationships Among Chronic Pain, Hypervigilance, and Executive Function." She received the Dashiell-Thurstone Prize at Commencement.



Dr. Patrick Harrison, a lecturer, and Maya Mosner, a graduate student in Clinical Psychology, are the 2017 recipients of Psi Chi's Award for Outstanding Teaching. Psi Chi recognizes a faculty member and a graduate student who helps undergraduate students grow through teaching, research, and mentorship. Dr. Harrison and Maya were honored for their tremendous impact on the Department and its students at the Psychology and Neuroscience Commencement Ceremony on May 14, 2017.

Dr. Keely Muscatell, an Assistant Professor of Social Psychology, and Julia Browne, a graduate student in Clinical Psychology, were this year's recipients of the Psychology Club's Award for Excellence in Research Mentoring. These awards are selected via student nominations to recognize outstanding mentorship for undergraduates. Dr. Muscatell won for her dedication in training undergraduates in biomedical studies research experiences and for advising two senior honors theses during her first year at Carolina. Julia won for her strong commitment to fostering research development through advising, helping students navigate the graduate school process, and her work to assist undergraduates get published. Dr. Muscatell and Julia go above and beyond in their mentorship of our undergraduate researchers. Both were honored at the Psychology and Neuroscience Commencement Ceremony on May 14, 2017.

Dr. Enrique Neblett, an Associate Professor of Clinical Psychology, received the 2017 Faculty Award for Excellence in Doctoral Mentoring. The Graduate School presents this annual award to a faculty member who has encouraged graduate students to establish their own records of scholarly activity, provided a supportive environment that brings forth the very best from their students, and achieved a successful record of graduate degree completion among students he or she has advised. Dr. Neblett was honored with this award at the Doctoral Hooding Commencement on May 13, 2017.

Dr. Karen Gil, a Lee G. Pederson Distinguished Professor of Clinical Psychology, received the 2017 William F. Little Distinguished Service Award for her service to the College and her outstanding leadership. A proclamation praised Dr. Gil as a "devoted scholar, visionary leader, and champion of the arts and sciences." Dean Kevin Guskiewicz noted that she was a mentor to many in the College, including himself. Dr. Gil joined the faculty in 1995, served as senior associate dean for undergraduate education from 2001 to 2004, chair of the Department from 2001 to 2004, and senior associate dean for social sciences and global programs from 2007 to 2009. Some of her accomplishments during her tenure as Dean (2009 to 2015) include strengthening the academic core of the College, dramatically improving Carolina's four and six year graduation rates, creating the first new science departments in 40 years, expanding global educational offerings, adding a new master's program in global studies, enhancing the minor in entrepreneurship, doubling the size of Honors Carolina, encouraging institutional innovations, appointing the first director of



faculty diversity initiatives, and hiring more women in the sciences. Dr. Gil was honored at the Arts and Foundation Board of Directors Meeting on May 3, 2017.



Diversity in Research Awards

Isai Garcia-Baza, a graduating senior, is the recipient of the third annual Susan M. McHale Award for Outstanding Psychological Research by a Student Who Enhances Diversity. The McHale Award's purpose to encourage and honor undergraduate students from underrepresented groups who make a contribution to the advancement of knowledge of psychological science. Isai received this award for his research, which is focused on the educational attainment expectations in Hispanic youth, parental influences on students' motivation, and cultural values that foster and/or interfere with college matriculation. As a first-generation college student and the son of Mexican immigrants, Isai is personally familiar with the barriers to higher education faced by Hispanic youth. Isai was honored with the Susan M. McHale Award at the Psychology and Neuroscience Commencement Ceremony on May 14, 2017.







Katie Reiter-Lavery and Megan Foxworth, graduating seniors, are the recipients of the third annual J. Steven Reznick Award for Diversity Enhancement in Psychological Research. The purpose of this award is to encourage and honor undergraduate students who make a contribution to the advancement of knowledge concerning issues that face diverse populations are that are of concern to diverse populations.

Katie was honored with this award for her outstanding research project which examines how social support interacts with the experiences of racial discrimination to influence mental health in African Americans. Her project was innovative in its use of longitudinal design to examine how changes over time in experiences of discrimination and

different types of social support predict declines in mental health functioning—one of the first studies of its kind. Katie's findings shed important light on how researchers need to consider different types of social support in studies linking discrimination and health.

Megan won for her excellent undergraduate honors thesis studying the interaction between racial socialization and exposure to racebased bias in predicting mental health in young children. She came



up with the ideas, measures, and approach to her research project. Her conceptualization of the problem and her approach was remarkably sophisticated, especially considering that she is an undergraduate researcher and she worked independently on the project. Her goal is to understand how racial socialization might buffer the effects of racial discrimination for young children. Megan is committed to helping underrepresented minorities succeed, despite experiencing racial discrimination and other experiences of early adversity. Megan and Katie were honored with the Reznick Award at our graduation ceremony.

Dr. Kate Reissner, an Assistant Professor of Behavioral and Integrative Neuroscience, is the recipient of a 2017 National Institute of Drug Abuse Summer Research supplement grant. The NIDA Summer Research Internship Program supports all students with a focus on increasing underrepresented populations in drug abuse research. Through this program, students age 18 years and older are introduced to the field of drug abuse and addiction research by participating in research internships with NIDA's distinguished scientists at universities across the United States. Students work with leading scientists for eight weeks during the summer. The internship may include laboratory experiments, data collection, formal courses, participation in lab meetings, patient interviews, manuscript preparation, library research, and literature reviews.

Jennifer Yi, a graduate student in Clinical Psychology, is the recipient of a 2017 National Institutes of Health Predoctoral Fellowship. The NIH Predoctoral Fellowship is awarded to graduate students with supervised research training in specific health and health-related areas leading toward the research degree. Jennifer received a total award of over \$70,000 (over two years) for her project, "Working Memory Network Connectivity and Inhibitory Control in Cocaine Use."
