Dr. Enrique Neblett, Associate Professor of Clinical Psychology, was honored as a graduate of the Thorp Faculty Engaged Scholars program during a lunch celebration at the George Watts Hill Alumni Center on August 23rd. The Thorp FES program brings together select faculty from across campus for a two-year experiential, competency-based curriculum designed to advanced their engaged scholarship. Dr. Neblett's project through Thorp FES employed photovoice, group interviews, and community engagement sessions to examine issues of racial equity and mental health care disparities for African American children, youth, and families in Raleigh, NC. He aspires to develop interventions and life-based learning for Black youth that may assist in negotiating the negative mental and physical health consequences of individual, institutional, cultural, and structural racism in the community.

Dr. Keith Payne, Professor of Social Psychology, Dr. Kristjen Lundberg, Alumna of the Social Psychology doctoral program, and Heidi Vuletich, a graduate student in Developmental and Social Psychology, are the recipients of the International Social Cognition Network (ISCON) 2017 Best Cognition Paper Award. Their paper, "The Bias of Crowds: How Implicit Bias Bridges Personal and Systemic Prejudice," was published in *Psychological Inquiry* and adopts a theoretically novel and creative approach to addressing some of the biggest puzzles still challenging this research area. The authors combine an unusually broad level of analysis with the very basic notion of concept accessibility to radically reorient our way of thinking about implicit bias, what it means, and how it works. Dr. Barbara Fredrickson, a Kenan Distinguished Professor of Social Psychology, is the recipient of a 2018 Templeton World Charity Foundation grant. Templeton World Charity Foundation, Inc. was established to serve as a global philanthropic catalyst for discoveries related to big questions of life and the universe, in areas of science, theology, philosophy, and human society. Dr. Fredrickson received a total award of over \$234,00 over two years for her project, "Understanding Everyday Love: Do Increases in Positivity Resonance Increase Virtuous Behavior?"

Dr. Sylvia Fitting, an Assistant Professor of Behavioral and Integrative Neuroscience, is the recipient of a 2018 R21 grant by the National Institute on Drug Abuse. This mechanism supports exploratory and high-risk projects that may lead to a breakthrough or development of novel techniques, models, or strategies, or generate pilot or feasibility data. Dr. Fitting was awarded over \$241,000 over one year for her project, "Mapping HIV-TAT +/- Endocannabinoid Induced Synaptic Changes at the Macro-molecular Level via Cyroelectron Tomography."

Dr. Erica Wise, Clinical Professor and Director of Psychological Services, was named an Initial Fellow by the Society of Clinical Psychology Division. Achieving Initial Fellow status in the American Psychological Association has always been associated with the recognition that the individual has achieved great distinction in their field. For Division 12, criteria for Fellowship can have a broad range, including direct therapeutic services, consultation, administration, research, and involvement in professional governance activities.

Dr. Amanda Elton, a Research Assistant Professor in Behavioral and Integrative Neuroscience, is the recipient of a 2018 National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism (NIAAA) K01 grant. Through the Mentored Research Scientist Development Award (K01), the NIAAA supports researchers at the start of their career by providing protected time and mentoring in an environment where they can develop the skills and expertise for independent research. Dr. Elton received a total award of over \$770,000 over five years for her project, "The Neural Mechanisms of Risk for Alcohol Use Disorder among College Students."

Dr. Enrique Neblett, Associate Professor, is a recipient of a 2018 Detroit Community-Academic Urban Research Center grant. The Detroit-Academic URC's mission is to enhance understanding of the relationship between the social and physical environmental determinants of health, and translate that knowledge into public health interventions, programs, and policies aimed at promoting health equity. Dr. Neblett received a total award of \$10,000 for his project, "Let's Talk About Race!"

Dr. Jessica Cohen, an Assistant Professor in Cognitive Psychology, is a recipient of a 2018 National Institutes of Health R01 grant. Dr. Cohen received a total award of over \$214,000 over one year for her project, "Neuroimaging of Visual Attention in Aging."





Dr. Kurt Gray, an Associate Professor of Social Psychology, is a recipient of a 2018 National Science Foundation grant. Dr. Gray received a total award of over \$403,000 over three years for his project, "Rationality of Harm Avoidance and Political Tolerance."

Dr. David Penn, a Wagner-Martin Distinguished Professor of Clinical Psychology, is a recipient of a 2018 National Institute of Mental Health R34 grant. The R34 mechanism supports clinical exploratory/ developmental grants and provides resources evaluating the feasibility, tolerability, acceptability, and safety of novel approaches to improving mental health and modifying health risk behavior, and for obtaining the preliminary data needed as a prerequisite to a larger-scale intervention or services study. Dr. Penn received over \$710,000 over three years for his project, "Targeting Physical Health in Schizophrenia: Physical Activity Can Enhance Life (PACE-Life)."

Dr. Margaret Sheridan, an Assistant Professor of Clinical Psychology, is a recipient of a National Institute of Mental Health R01. Dr. Sheridan received a total award of over \$3.7 million over five years for her project, "Do Dimensions of Adversity Differentially Predict Neural Development and Psychopathology in Young Children?"

Dr. Seth Hurley, a postdoctoral fellow in the Behavioral and Integrative Neuroscience Program and a member of Dr. Regina Carelli's laboratory, is a recipient of a 2018 National Institutes of Mental Health F32 Fellowship. This postdoctoral fellowship award is designed to enhance the research training of promising postdoctoral candidates who have the potential to become productive, independent investigators in scientific health-related research fields. Dr. Hurley received over \$124,000 over two years for his project, "Corticolimbic Circuitry Mediating Negative Affect."
