Three of our instructors have won 2019 University Teaching Awards! Congratulations to Dr. Beth Kurtz-Costes, Dr. Marsha Penner, and Holly Shablack!



Dr. Kurtz-Costes, a Zachary Taylor Smith Distinguished Term Professor of Developmental Psychology, won the William C. Friday/ Class of 1986 Award for Excellence in Teaching. This award was created by members of the 1986 graduating class to recognize members of the faculty who have exemplified excellence in inspirational teaching and is named in honor of William C. Friday.



Dr. Marsha Penner, a Teaching Assistant Professor, won the Tanner Award for Excellence in Undergraduate Teaching. This award was created in 1952 in memory of Lola Spencer and Simpson Bobo Tanner. The award was established to recognized excellence in inspirational teaching of undergraduate students, particularly first and second-year students.



Holly Shablack, a graduate student in Social Psychology, won the Tanner Award for Excellence in Undergraduate Teaching by a Graduate Teaching Assistant. This award was created in 1990 by the University to expand the purview of the Tanner Awards to recognize the inspirational teaching by graduate students in their teaching of undergraduate students.

Dr. Kurtz-Costes, Dr. Penner, and Holly, along with 21 other faculty members and graduate students, are the winners of Carolina's 2019 University Teaching Awards. They will receive one-time stipends, framed citations, be recognized at the UNC-Syracuse men's basketball game on February 26, and honored at an awards banquet on April 8!
